Dear Parents:

I am writing to inform parents of a recent Ordinance passed by the Township of Little Falls regarding parking at the Township Schools during the day.

As you may recall, we have had a number of situations at Little Falls School #2 over the past few years where drivers refused to cooperate in regard to moving their cars when asked to by school staff. This lack of cooperation and safety concern forced the district to move forward with the Township the request to pass binding ordinances that allow the Little Falls Police Department to ticket vehicles or have them towed as may be required.

The local ordinance prohibits parking on Municipal and Board of Education Property as noted below for each of our schools:

“No person shall park a vehicle on the property of the Little Falls Board of Education parking areas at School No. 1, No. 2, and No. 3 between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. except those vehicles bearing Board of Education ID stickers, issued by that authority. No person shall park a vehicle on such property between 5:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m. unless in attendance at school functions.”

We ask that parents and community members be aware of this change and cooperate with the district as needed. It is certainly not our intention to have the Little Falls Police ticket our residents, but we will definitely look to enforce this Ordinance as required should individuals create the need to have the school call the Police for assistance with traffic flow and/or parking.

We appreciate your understanding in this change in policy and realize that this new procedure will protect the health and safety of our students in all three of our buildings. Please feel free to contact your child's principal should you have any questions. Thank you.
