

A Note from the Health Office

Dear Preschool Parents,

All children entering Preschool in 2010 are required to have a physical examination and a documented series of immunizations. Immunizations required by the state of New Jersey are:

- ❖ DPT, 4 doses with one dose given on or after the 4th birthday
- ❖ Polio, 3 doses with one dose given on or after the 4th birthday
- ❖ MMR, 1dose after 1 year of age
- ❖ Hepatitis B, 3 doses
- ❖ Varicella, 1dose after 1 year of age or documentation of date of disease.
- ❖ Pneumococcal Conjugate Vaccine 1 dose for every child 12 months through 59 months of age after the first birthday and attending preschool.
- ❖ Influenza Vaccine 1dose for every child six months through 59 months of age attending preschool with the dose given between September 1 and December 31 of each school year.

In addition, a recent physical exam (within 364 days from the start of school) must be presented.

Documentation of the above requirements must be on file **before** the start of the school year except for the Influenza Vaccine. If your child does not have the proper documentation he/she will be unable to attend on opening day.
