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Dear Parents and Guardians,

Pursuant to N.J.S.A 18A:7C-6.6, districts must provide parents and guardians certain information on any state or commercially developed standardized assessment that will be administered during the school year. Below, please find the Little Falls Public School key to understanding the assessment calendars and testing information. New Jersey Student Learning Assessment (NJSLA) testing is required through the federal government. This is a comprehensive list and not all students take all of the assessments. Please note that as the testing dates approach, you will receive more detailed information.

Key to understanding the assessment calendars:

- **Testing Mode** refers to how the assessment will be administered to students. The two modes are computer-based and paper based. Some computer-based assessments allow students to take the assessment using paper and pencil. Be sure to inquire about the options if your child has a medical issue that would not allow them to take the assessment on the computer.
- **Testing Time** is the maximum amount of time allotted to students to complete the assessment.
- **Testing Window** is the period of time in which districts administer the assessment. It is not the actual number of days it takes a student to complete the assessment. School districts can choose the specific days within the window to administer the test. Building principals will share exact dates as testing window nears.
- **Results Available** refers to the date districts receive individualized student results from the assessment. These results are distributed to students, educators, and families as soon as possible.
