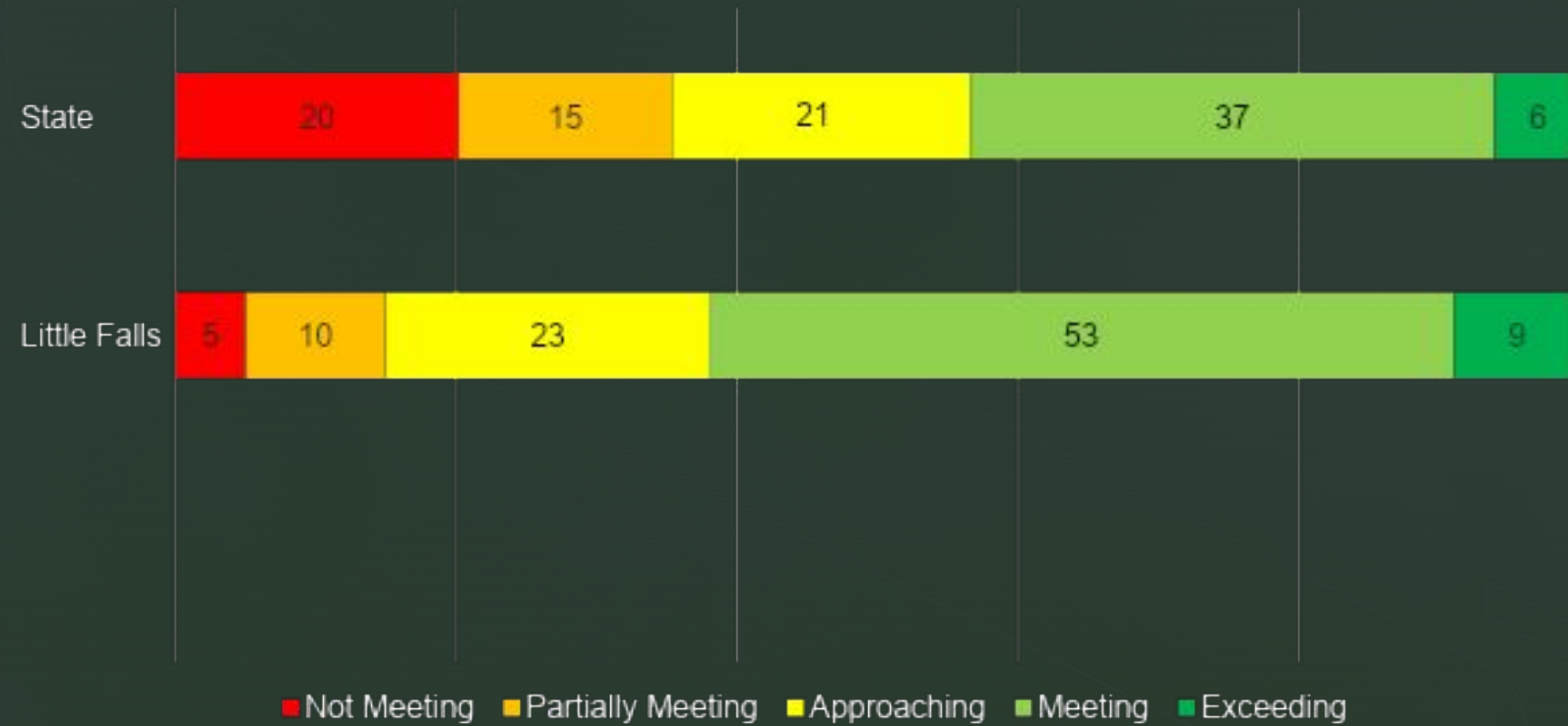

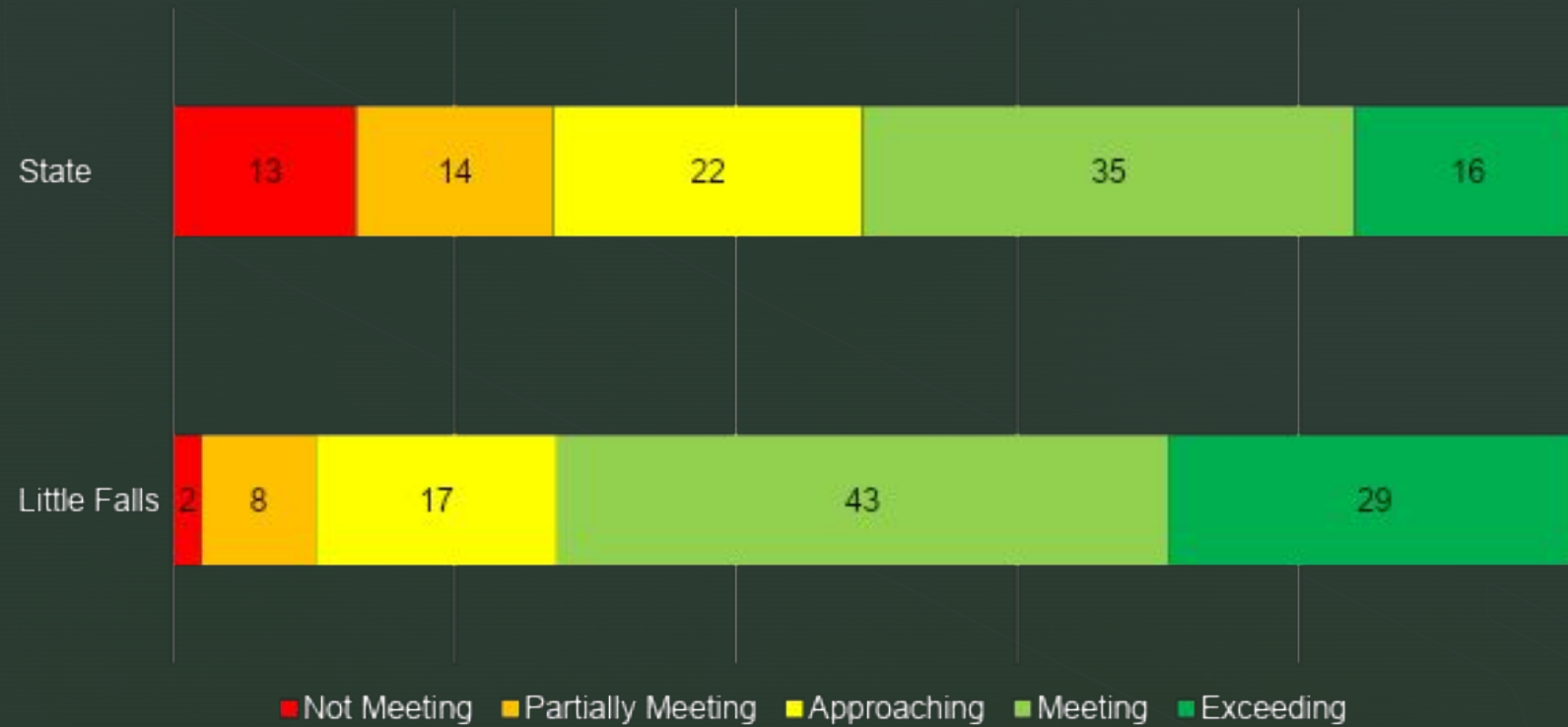

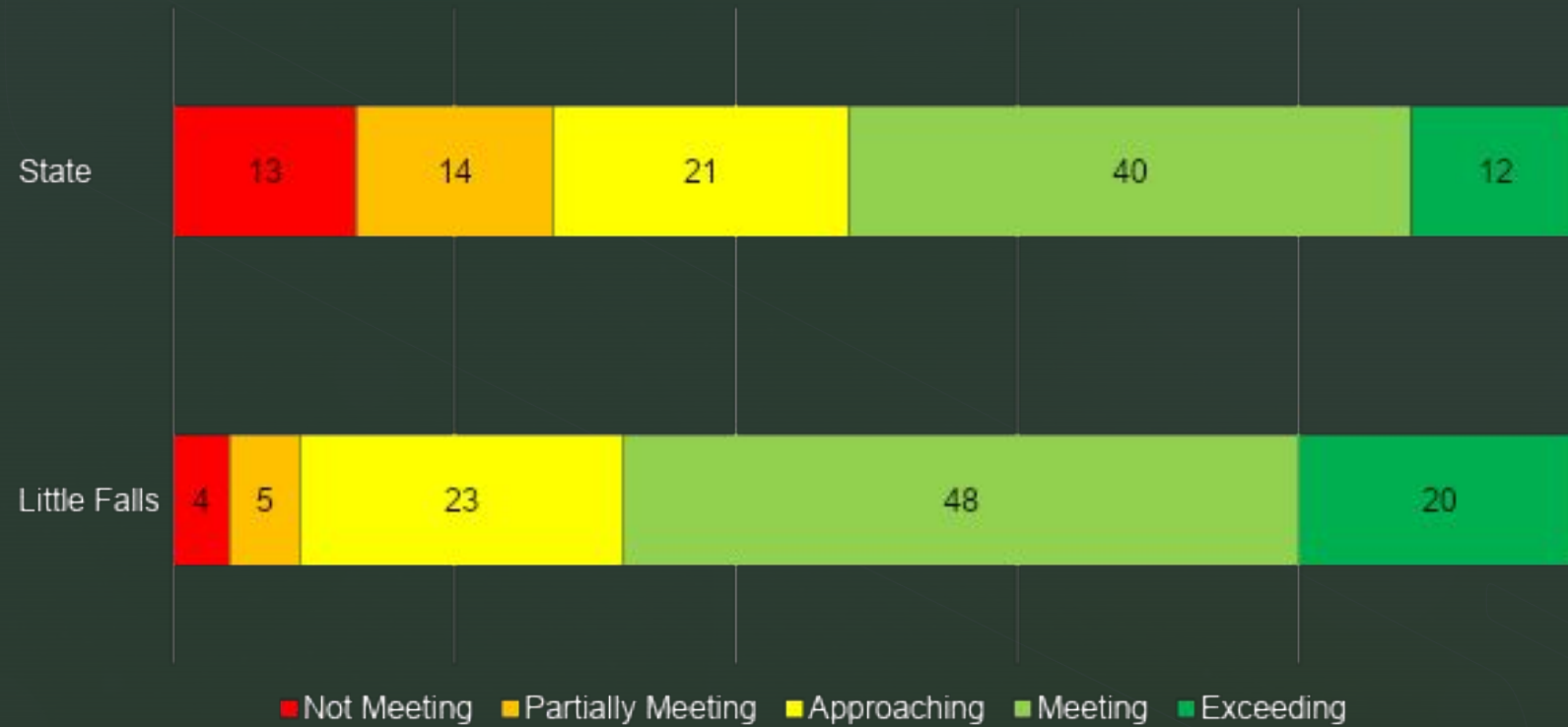

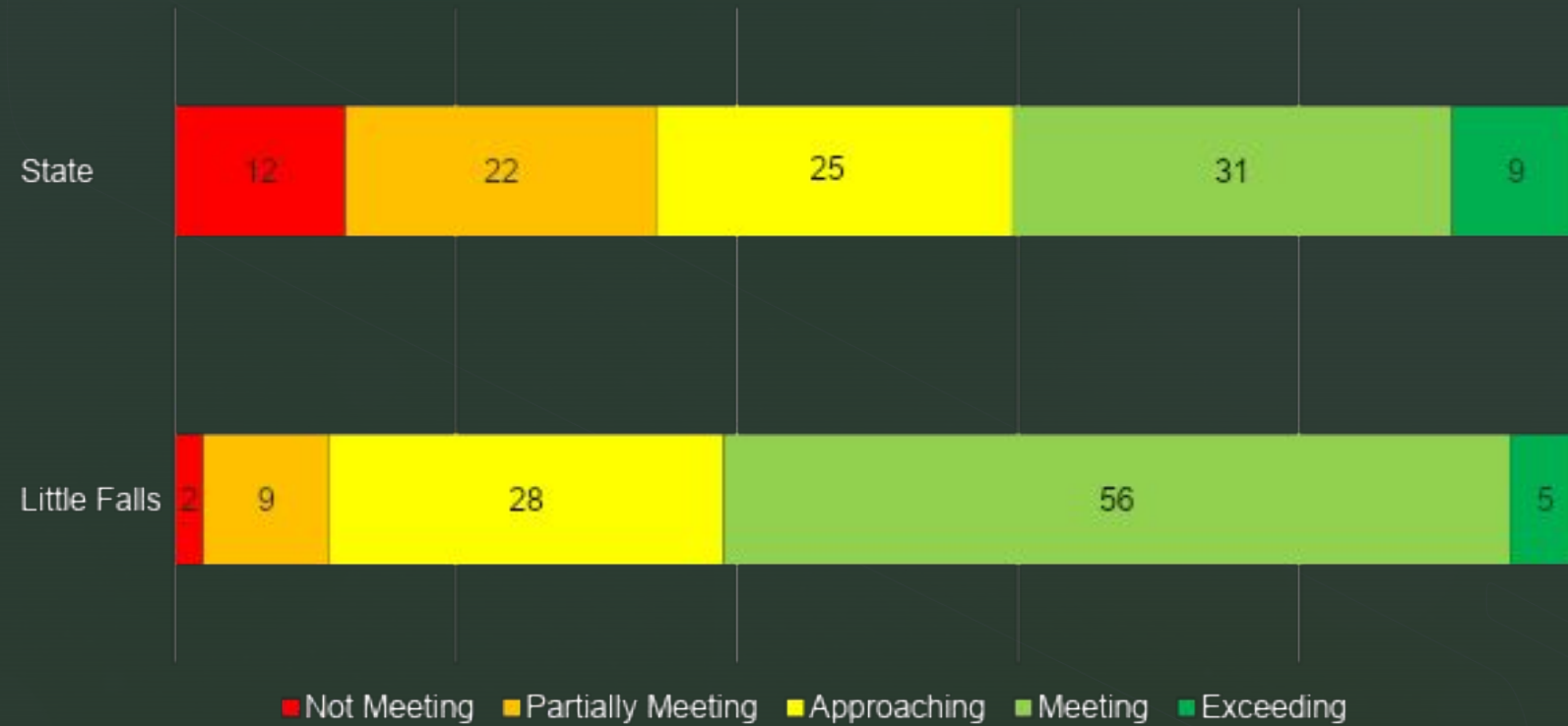

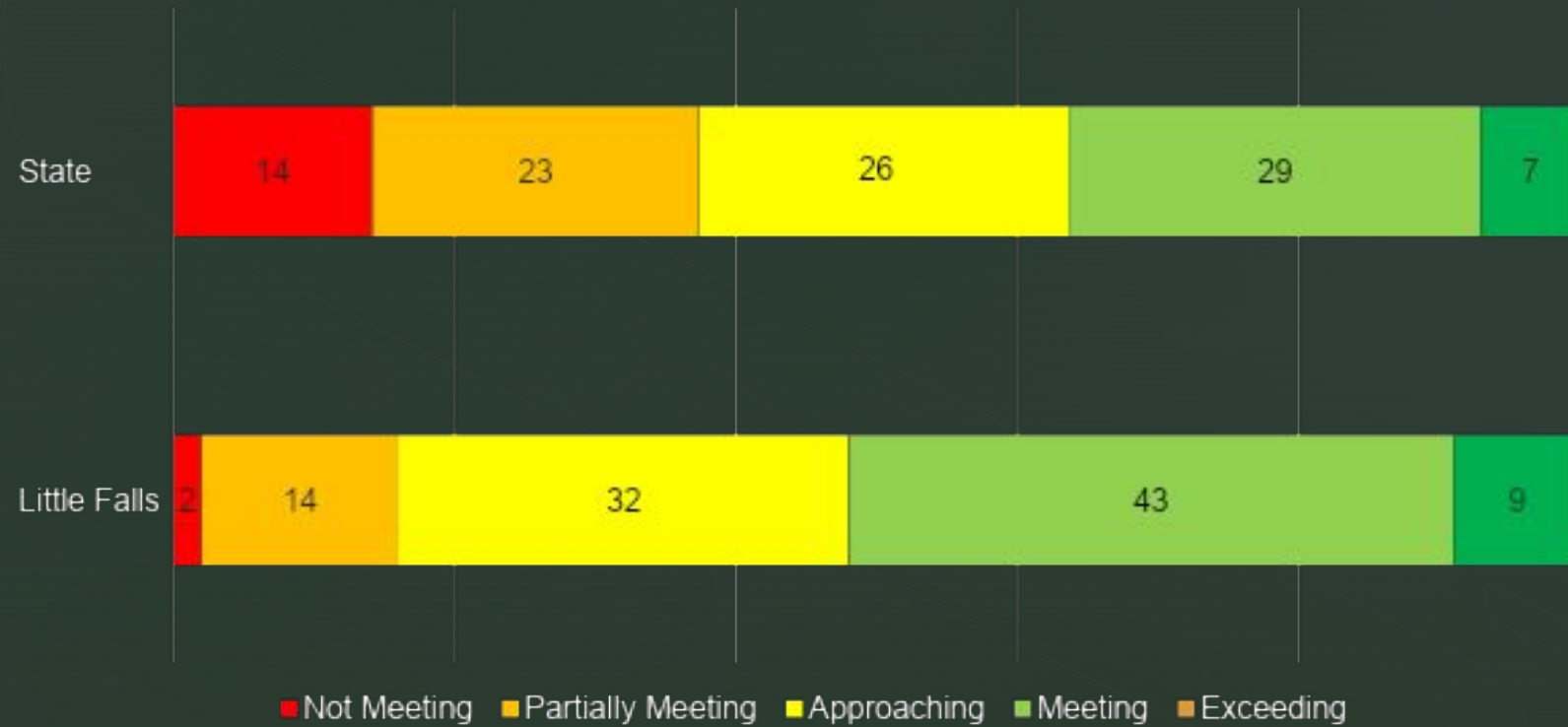

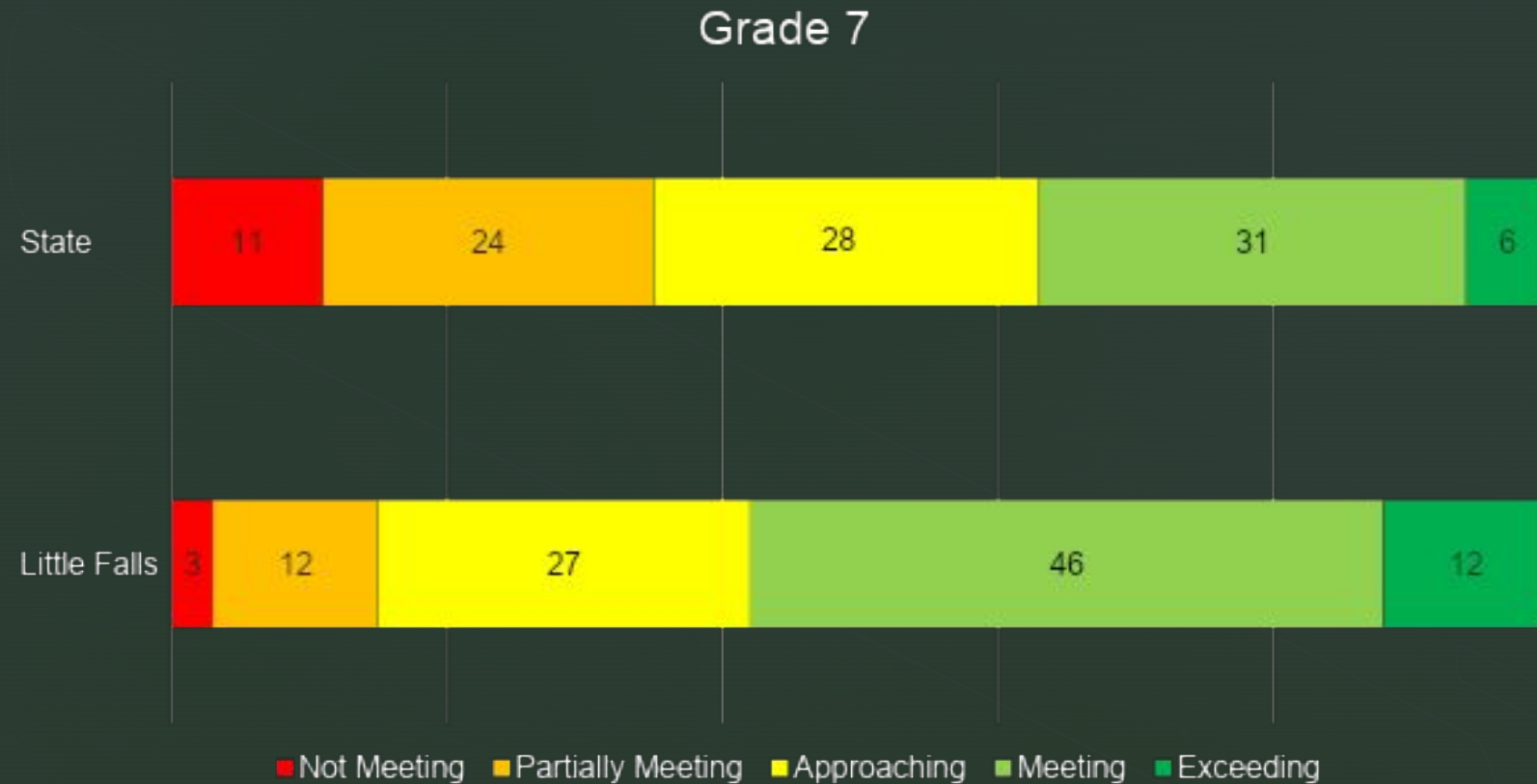

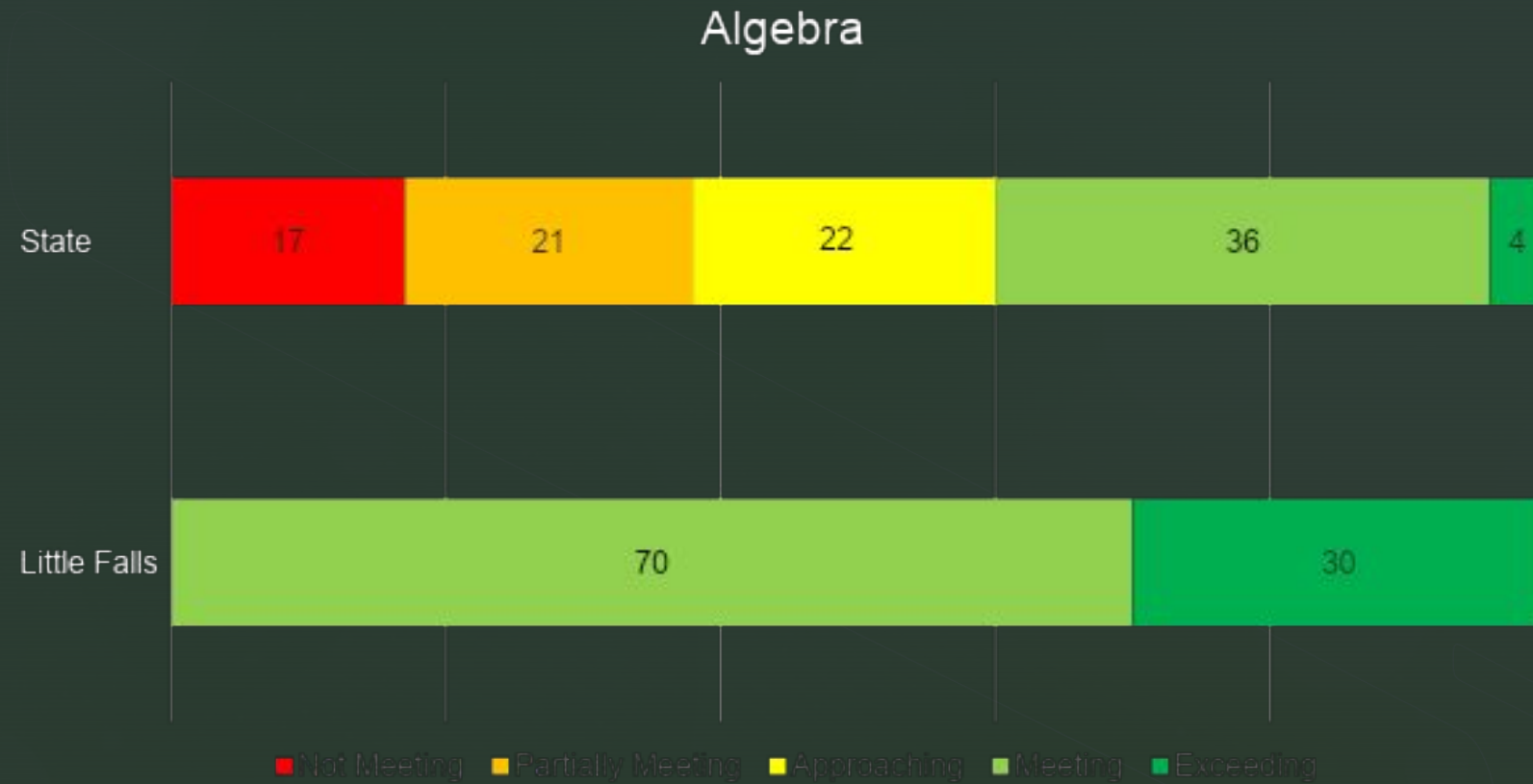

Grade 5 math increased from 31% to 61%

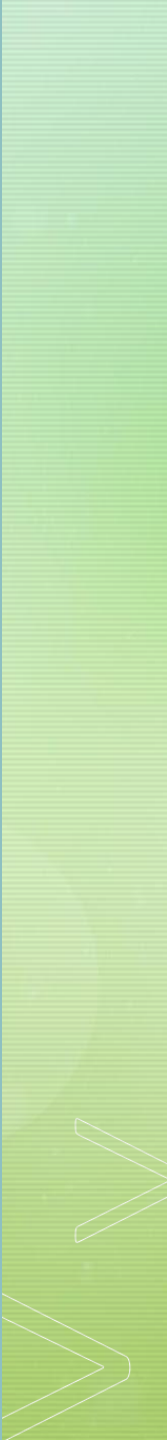
Grade 6 math increased from 33% to 52%

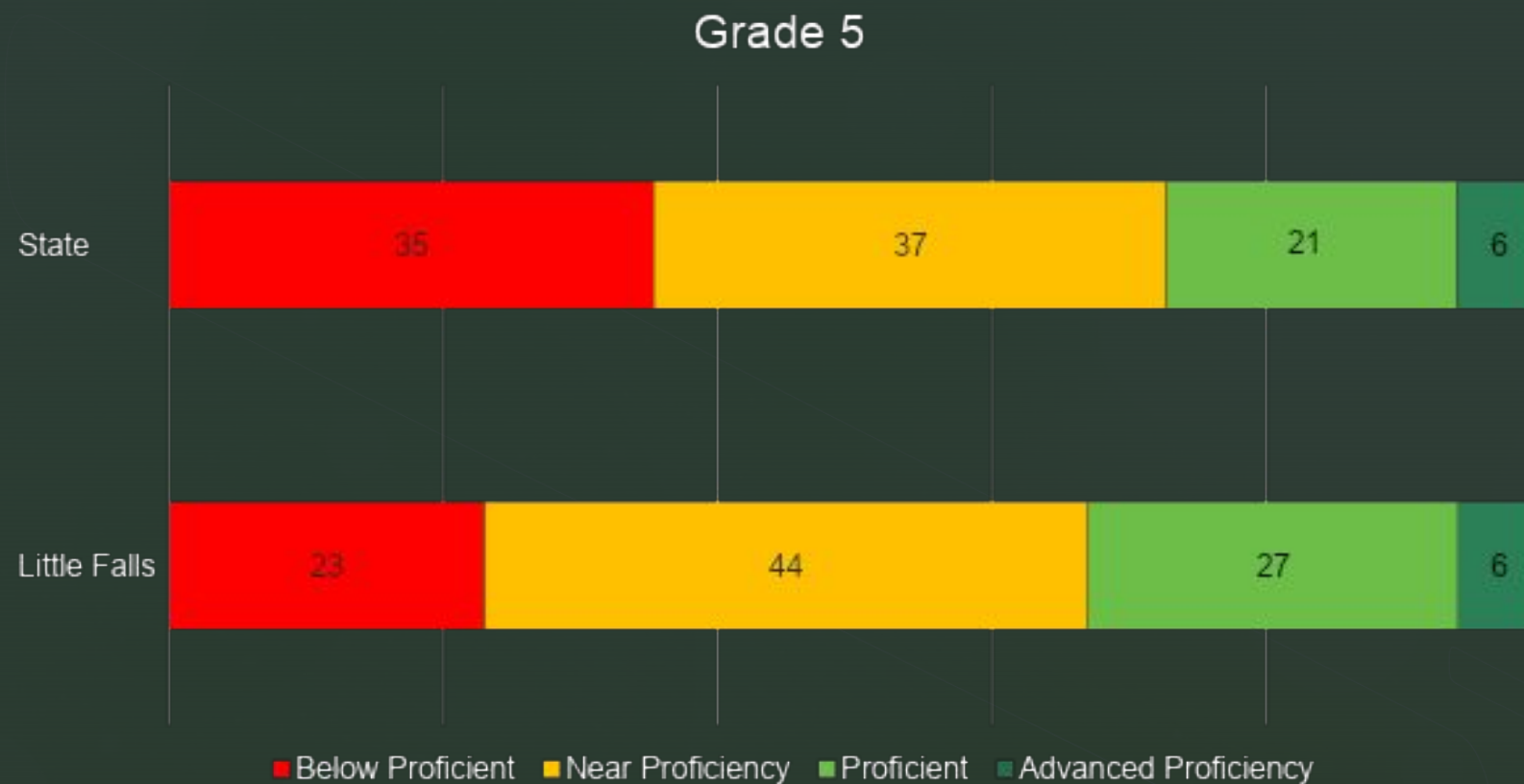

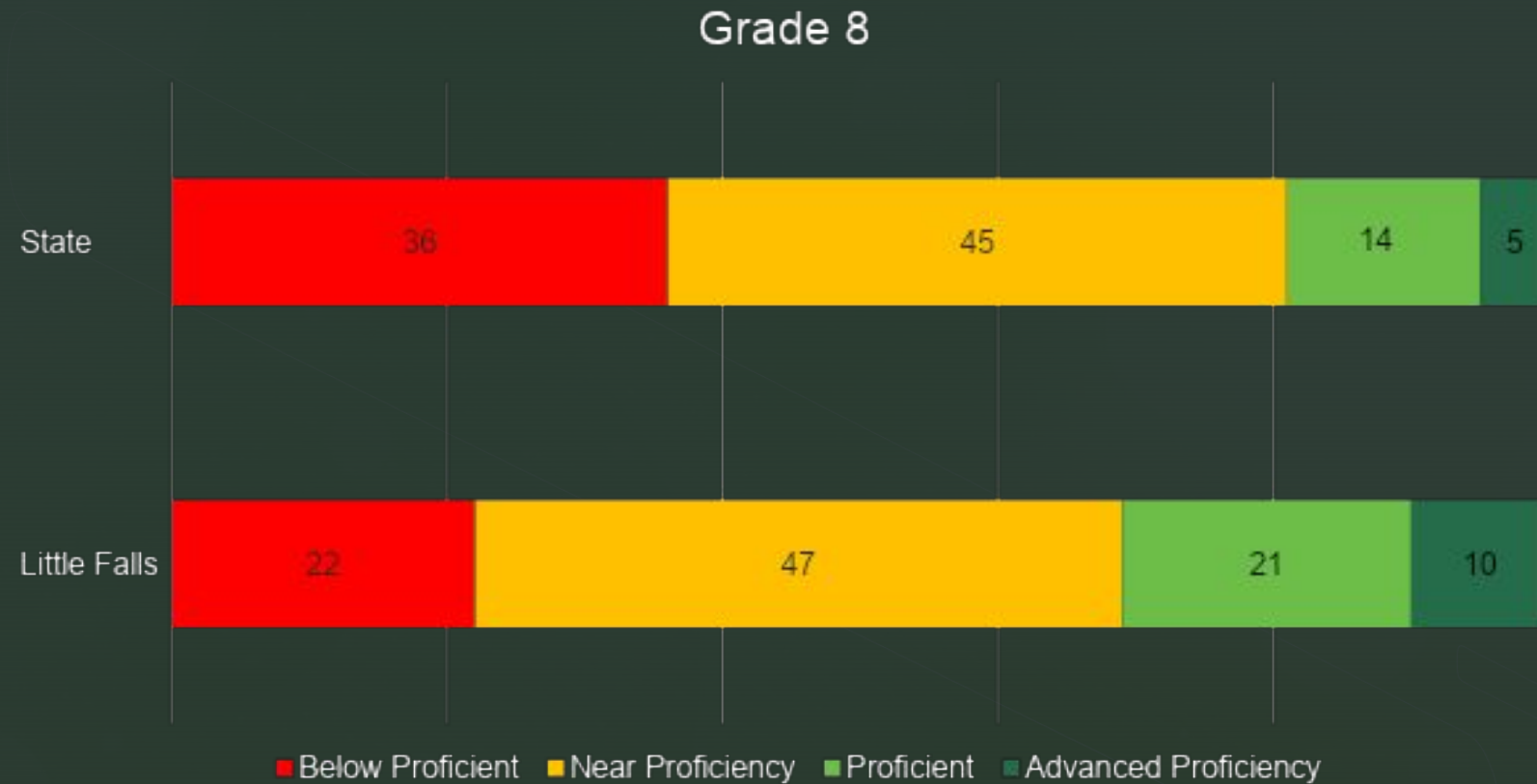

Little Falls saw an overall increase of meeting and exceeding by 5%

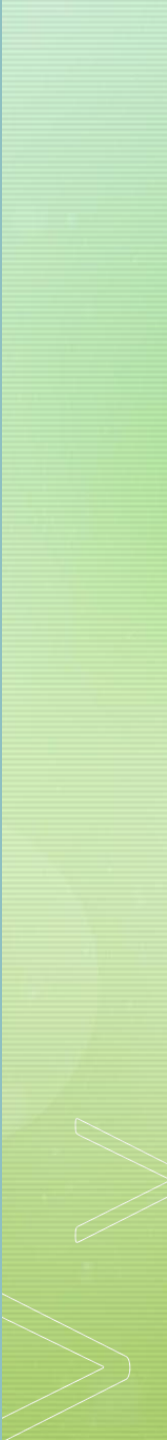
Little Falls saw an overall decrease of below proficiency by 8%
